A pilot workshop using tools from improvisation and theatre to explore community resilience practices led by UCI community member, artist, and scholar Giulia Vittori. At the Cross-Cultural Center. Open to all.

## FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Nov 14 - 16, 2019

A conversation on community gardening and the movement for equitable food systems in Orange County followed by work in the CRECE Cooperative garden in Santa Ana. Part of UCI Hunger and Homelessness Awareness week. Open to all.

## COOPERATION IN ACTION

Nov 21, 2019

A 12-week course on creating worker cooperatives for low-income residents of Santa Ana together with Cooperacion Santa Ana. November 21 graduation at Newkirk Alumni Center. By invitation.
