

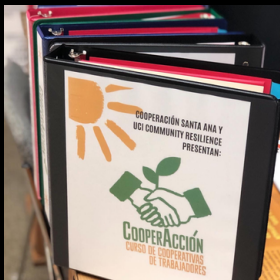
UCI Community Resilience

TRAINING + FACILITATION

We train UC & CSU students, faculty, staff & teachers, community collaborators, through a 3-day Leadership Institute for Climate Resilience. We co-design & facilitate community visioning & action planning.



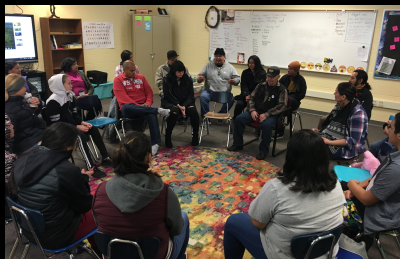
COOPERACIÓN CURRÍCULUM

We co-design courses with Cooperación Santa Ana for residents on worker cooperatives and for campus partners on shifting from community engagement to community ownership.



REGIONAL RESILIENCE

We support youth-led investigation into lead soil levels and an urban farming cooperative in Santa Ana, California.



NATIONAL

We support *encuentro* between Santa Ana communities and communities within the Menominee Nation working for a just transition. We support the Climate Refugees Stories Project and are partner to the National Association of Climate Resilience Planners.
